

Introduction to the Vaccine Controversy

1. The CDC claims vaccines are “safe and effective.” But in 2011, the U.S. Supreme Court said that vaccines are “**unavoidably unsafe**.”¹
2. Federal government payouts for vaccine injury and death:²
 - a. Total to date (1989 - February 2016): \$ 3.3 Billion
 - b. Average annual payout FY 1989-2015: \$120 Million per year
 - c. Average annual payout FY 2011-2015: \$227 Million per year
 - d. Cases pending (Mar 2016): 2,353
3. Vaccine manufacturers have **no liability** for the harm cause by their vaccines, and thus no incentive to make safer products.³
4. 90-95% of 20th century childhood infectious disease mortality decline **preceded** the introduction of vaccines.⁴ Vaccines are not the reason we have low disease death rates today.
5. The AMA’s Code of Medical Ethics recommends “**medical, religious, or philosophic**” [sic] immunization exemptions for medical doctors.⁵
6. The pharmaceutical industry is the **biggest defrauder** of the federal government under the False Claims Act.⁶ In a recent 5 year period, **\$19.2 billion** were returned from attempts to defraud federal health programs, more than twice that of the previous 5 years.⁷
7. From 2001 to 2015, there were 37 pharmaceutical fines (combined criminal/civil) from \$100 million and \$3 billion.⁸ **Criminal fines** have been as high as **\$1 billion** (Pfizer 2009, GlaxoSmithKline 2012).
8. Numerous medical studies document disease outbreaks in highly and even fully vaccinated populations.⁹

I. If the federal government can’t agree whether vaccines are “safe and effective” or “unavoidably unsafe,” who should have the final say—government or private citizens and their healthcare professionals?

II. Should anyone ever be required to take a product from an industry that routinely engages in massive criminal behavior?

III. Since there’s a risk, there must be a choice!
